



## FAQs #2, 15 December 2016

### SYDNEY JAMBOREE 2018 PLANNING COMMITTEE

All team roles currently required have been assigned. Leaders/Managers/Adult members will be able to apply, via application process from May 2017, to be assigned to a specific team for Sydney Jamboree 2018.

### WHO CAN ATTEND THE JAMBOREE?

To attend the Jamboree as a Youth Member, you must be:

- 10 years old (or older), on 1 June 2018, **and**
- 17 years old (or younger) on 30 September 2018.

Girls who will be 14 years old on 30 September 2018 can choose to be placed in a patrol aged 10–14 years old, or 14–17 years old.

Members who are 18 years old (or older) on 30 September 2018 can attend as Adults.

Adults will have the option to attend the Jamboree for the full week, single days, or part days.

### PARTICIPANT FEES

Youth Members \$1250

Adult Members (full week's attendance) \$700

*Note: Adult fees for single days and part days will be advised in 2017*

*Note: Contingent and travel fees are NOT included.*

We suggest that Units, Districts and Regions use a range of fundraising opportunities, such as donations, grants, service club allocations, community BBQs, and confectionery sales to raise the funds to attend this International event.

### PARTICIPANT KITS

Full time participants will receive a kit consisting of a hat, reusable water bottle, event shirt and event badge inside a duffle-style wheelie bag. Part time participants can choose whether they wish to receive a kit.
