WHEN IS THE JAMBOREE IN 2018?

30 September, 2018 to 6 October, 2018

Leaders, not travelling with contingents, will arrive on Saturday, 29th September, 2018.

Girls (and leaders travelling with contingents) will all arrive on Sunday, 30th September, 2018.

All participants will depart on Saturday, 6th October, 2018.

Committee, Group teams and leaders remaining to assist bump out will depart on Sunday, 7th October, 2018.

WHERE WILL THE JAMBOREE IN 2018 BE HELD?

The Jamboree will be held at Sydney Olympic Park/Newington Armory.

WHAT WILL THE JAMBOREE COST?

The costs for youth members will be advised as soon as possible. As an indicator please budget for \$1600 which should include the youth cost of the base Jamboree, potential specific chosen day off site and whole camp day off site as well as on site fun and challenging activities. Travel costs and State contingent fees are not included and will be extra.

WHAT WILL THE JAMBOREE BE CALLED?

WHAT AGE GIRL GUIDES CAN ATTEND?

Girls who are aged 10–14 at the time of the camp, financial members and attending 10+ Unit

Girls who are aged 14–17 at the time of the camp, financial members and attending 14+ Unit

Leaders/adult members who are 18 or over at the time of camp and financial members.

CAN GIRLS APPLY IN PATROLS?

Girls can nominate one or two other girls (who are either 10–14 or 14–17) they would like to be patrolled with.

CAN LEADERS APPLY IN TEAMS?

Yes - Leaders can apply as members of a sub-camp team. (1. Sub-camp Leader, 2. Caterer, 3. Caterer, 4. First Aid & Hygiene, 5. Program & Intl.)

HOW WILL ADULTS BE GROUPED?

All Leaders/adults not allocated to Group or Sub-camp teams will be allocated to one Central Group for adults.

WILL LEADERS BE ABLE TO ATTEND FOR SPECIFIC DAYS?

Leaders will be able to nominate to attend specific days when members of Central Group. Leaders who apply for, and are allocated to, Group and Sub-camp teams should be prepared to be fulltime.
