Facilities

Beds available for 26 persons:

- 2 dormitories sleeping 12 and 8
- Leaders' room sleeps 4
- Wattle room at back of cottage sleeps 2

Lounge/dining room with table and chairs for 36 people

Kitchen with full facilities - refrigerator, electric stove, pie warmer, microwave oven, cooking Utensils, crockery, cutlery and lots of storage space

Bathroom has 4 shower recesses and 3 toilets (septic system and tank water only)

BBQ at rear of cottage

Gas heating

Disables access

BYO all linen and blankets

Grassed area at side and rear of cottage for activities

Car parking only inside perimeter fence

Large well-kept grassed area

No telephone is available - leaders should bring a mobile phone in case of emergency



Windy Acres Campsite

Facilities

Amenities block with two hot showers and three toilets (septic system). TANK WATER ONLY

Fully equipped with tents, patrol boxes, cooking equipment

Large refrigerator and food storage cupboard

Undercover cooking facilities for wet weather

Large undercover area for wet weather activities and storage

Space for 50 campers

Power available

Electric Urn, fry pan, etc

Parking of cars should be inside our perimeter

No telephone is available - leaders should bring a mobile phone in case of emergency
