



How do I make a Bequest?

This may be as simple as adding a Codicil to your existing Will - seek a solicitor's advice on this.

There are three ways you can make a bequest to us in your Will:

1. A percentage, or the remains of your estate (known as the residue). This is the simplest option for you and will not be eroded by inflation.
2. A fixed amount of money
3. An asset (such as property, jewellery, works of art etc). Girl Guides NSW & ACT could, if your Will allows, sell the asset and convert it to money.

We recommend that you have a solicitor guide you in drawing up your Will, and advise you.

Your bequest (or gift) to Girl Guides NSW & ACT can take many forms, including:

- Cash or securities
- Real Estate
- Life Insurance policies
- Annuities or Trusts
- Cultural property such as manuscripts, books and works of art.

Can I Specify the Target of My Bequest?

Yes, you can. However, bequests made without a designated purpose will have greater flexibility. They will be able to assist in energising, supporting and developing Girl Guides NSW & ACT in the second century of Guiding.
