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### COMPLETE ACTIVITIES 1-4

1. **Complete the appropriate syllabus for the Community Harmony badge**
2. **Promote Australian multiculturalism**
  - Citizenship means you become a member of a country, with rights and responsibilities to that country.  
Find someone in your community who was born outside Australia but has chosen to become Australian. Ask them why they chose to become an Australian citizen.
3. **Be involved in Australian multiculturalism**
  - Harmony Day is held on 21 March each year to celebrate Australia's cultural diversity. Organise your Unit to do something special for the Harmony Day celebration . If you have missed Harmony Day, you may still choose another day – perhaps United Nations Children's Day in October or Reconciliation Week, OR
  - Orange is the Harmony day colour; organise to wrap orange ribbons around your hall or yourself to show your support, OR
  - Invite a friend from a different cultural background to a Guide meeting and celebrate Harmony Day together.
4. **Advance Reconciliation**
  - Identify a well known Aboriginal person, find out what their achievement is, and tell your Unit.
