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#### COMPLETE ACTIVITIES 1-4

1. **Complete the appropriate syllabus of the Community Harmony Badge**
  2. **Promote Australian multiculturalism**
    - Find out why it is important to be an Australian citizen. Attend a local Citizenship ceremony and represent Girl Guides NSW & ACT; OR
    - Find out what an Affirmation Of Citizenship ceremony is, organise a ceremony in your District and invite the local community [Go to [www.immi.gov.au](http://www.immi.gov.au) and click on Citizenship for information]; OR
    - Visit the local historical society and research the history of the establishment of the suburb/town/city. Who are the original indigenous owners? From what other countries did other settlers come? Present your research to your Guide Unit; OR
    - A similar activity of your own choice
  3. **Be involved in Australian multiculturalism**
    - Harmony Day is held on 21 March each year. Find out what it is celebrating, organise an activity in your area and invite members of different cultural communities to attend. This activity can be held at any time of the year
    - Organise a stall and attend a multicultural Festival in your area to promote Guiding to girls of all cultural backgrounds; OR
    - A similar activity of your own choice
  4. **Advance Reconciliation**
    - National Reconciliation Week is held on 27 May – 3 June. Research the significance of these dates; plan an activity to celebrate National Reconciliation Week; OR
    - Reconciliation Australia has a number of ways people can assist voluntarily. Choose one and offer your services [See [www.reconciliationaustralia.org/docs/jobs/volunteer\\_opportunities.doc](http://www.reconciliationaustralia.org/docs/jobs/volunteer_opportunities.doc)]; OR
    - A similar activity of your own choice
